Bachelor of Laws (LL.B.), a Bachelor's degree with predominantly legal components, the „Erstes Staatsexamen“ or an international equivalent

### English Language Requirements:

English = first language

IELTS Academic overall 6.5 (no component lower than 6.5)

TOEFL 92 (no subtests less than 22, speaking not less than 23)

Cambridge C1 Advanced: B minimum

Cambridge C2 Proficiency: C minimum

PTE Academic 68, minimum 60 in writing

Applications can also be submitted if the Bachelor's degree is not yet completed. Applicants must prove a successful course completion of 81% of the required total performance (according to the study programme 180 or 210 ECTS).
