Admission Requirements	Education: • Bachelor of Laws (LL.B.), a Bachelor's degree with predominantly legal components, the "Erstes Staatsexamen" (first state examination) or an international equivalent English Language Requirements: • English as a first language or • IELTS Academic overall 6.5 (no subtest lower than 6.5) • TOEFL 92 (no subtests less than 22, speaking not less than 23) • Cambridge C1 Advanced: B minimum • Cambridge C2 Proficiency: C minimum • PTE Academic 68, minimum 60 in writing
